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E. **Prosocial Behavior:** The child interacts successfully with others, demonstrating an ability to problem-solve, cooperate and empathize.

Rating Scale: 0 = Not at all; 1 = Rarely; 2 = Occasionally; 3 = Often; 4 = Usually; 5 = Always/Consistently

1. Plays imitatively or in representational solitary play.
2. Actively watches others at play.
3. Plays in a parallel fashion near others, using similar toys or materials.
4. Has a range of appropriate imaginative play.
5. Acknowledges and accepts the approach or initiation of outreach by peers.
6. Initiates appropriate outreach to peers.
7. Engages in simple, brief interactions, responses or exchanges with peers.
8. Selects an alternative toy or activity if desired object is unavailable.
9. Shares toys or objects with adult support.
10. Accepts role reversals in play and follows the lead of others in play. (Complimentary or reciprocal play).
11. Plays in an extended fashion with one other child in at least one setting.
12. Shows a preference for one peer.

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13. Recognizes children have different abilities, skills and feelings.

14. Plays with different children in diverse play settings and activities, adapting to the changing demands of the evolving play. (Cooperative play).

15. Adapts play for the different abilities or familiarity of other children.
